Dear Friends,

'Sabbath' – was a gift from God to the people of Israel. God considered it to be holy and set this apart from other days. God Himself takes rest on the seventh day after creating all the wonderful things in the world. He expects us to follow the same and rest a while. We all need some time off from our routine work and events of life. Everyone needs a break. A good, proper and well-deserved rest re-energises us in such a way, we become more productive and efficient. At times, we think that we don't have time to rest and keep doing the work that we are busy with. The fact is that, we become counterproductive and inefficient.

In the Gospel of today, Jesus asks His disciples to take the rest that they need. He was aware that He has been very busy with the crowds of people, teaching them, healing them and leading them. His disciples too were part of Jesus' mission.

Taking rest does not mean, being lazy. It is about recharging our batteries to do better. Life is about 'Being more' rather than 'Doing more' or 'Having more'. The rest enhances us to be more to one another. Let us ponder on the following questions and answer them for ourselves:

- Have I spent some quality time in silence (without gadgets or TV)?
- Have I spent some quality time in reflection on my life?
- Have I spent some quality time in prayer and meditation?
- How am I looking at time with my family? Time with my parents? Children?
- What do I do when I rest? Do I indulge in Alcoholism or other addictions or do I value it?

THE MASS

What is the Structure of the Mass and why do we do what we do, in the Mass?

Archbishop Mark Coleridge takes us through the Catholic Mass in this multi part series.

<u>The Mass Series: Part 11 & Part 12 – Liturgy of the Eucharist – Eucharistic Prayer (Part 2), Communion Rite, Lord's Prayer</u>

Once we have done that, for the rest of the Eucharistic Prayer we call upon the power of Christ as once more we intercede for the Church, for the world, for ourselves and the dead. Because, again, this prayer has a power that reaches beyond death and can embrace the dead.

So, that once again you see how the Mass is an experience of communion of the living and the dead. A communion of those who are in heaven and those who are still on earth. Communion of the Church in every time and place through history and across the planet.

So, we're not just talking about this particular community that gathers to celebrate the Mass, we're talking about that community but gathered in this vast community that the communion of God has created through time and space. And then all of that remembering and interceding, eventually issues into what we call the doxology that concludes the Eucharistic Prayer: 'Through Him, With Him and in Him, To you O God Almighty Father, all glory and honour forever and ever.'

So, in other words, the great cry of praise. Praising God because once you have remembered and once you have seen the transforming power of God all you can do is issue into an ecstasy of praise and that's really where the great prayer concludes. The church has offered sacrifice to God. Has brought to God, gifts which God Himself has given us. Gifts of bread and wine but symbolising so much more.
