Dear Friends,

God hates the sins, but He loves the sinners. Yes, God hates the sins, but He loves the sinners. All of us have our own faults and failures. God always gives a second chance to the sinners to repent. We cannot see the real contrition in the hearts of people, but God can see it. We create a comfort zone around self-righteousness. We love judging others and finding faults with them. God is always compassionate and merciful.

In the Gospel, the mob caught a woman in the very act of adultery. They brought her to Jesus publicly. They in fact wanted to trap Jesus for not promoting the laws of Moses. What a situation for the woman to be humiliated in public. First of all, we need to understand the situation of this woman. She might be very poor that she cannot afford to feed her children or whatever the reason could have been. For a woman to do such a thing, she must have been desperate for help. These people who accused her didn't move a finger to help her, but they were ready to stone her to death. Pathetic! They were more concerned about fulfilling the law of Moses than helping each other.

When she was brought to Jesus, He didn't speak to her, nor told the people what they were doing was wrong. But told them to cast their stone if they were without sins. They left one by one beginning from the elders. Jesus knew that some of these accusers might have sinned with her. Also, He wanted them to realise that everyone has got their own sins.

We have got a couple of weeks to go for the Lenten season to finish. Where is our concentration right now? Is it on our self-righteousness or on the mercy of God? If we are busy with our self-righteousness, then we have not begun our Lent!
