Dear Friends,

Have you written your Curriculum Vitae anytime? How was the experience? How much of it was honest and how much of it was just to get the job? One of the questions that is being asked is that 'Why should we hire you?' Then we come up with lots of explanations and descriptions on how good we will be in the position and what we are capable of etc.

Jesus speaks about the taking up the places of honour and being greeted obsequiously in the market squares. He has reminded to the people that if we want to be the first, then be the last and if we want to be master than be the slave. That is the measuring scale which God uses in our lives. God's ways are unique and different from the world. But only the ways of God are long lasting in the world.

Credit cards are not accepted in heaven. We must pay from what we have saved up. The currency converting regulations are quite different in heaven in the eyes of God. He doesn't value money with the eyes of the world. For God, the quality matters more than quantity. Our inner disposition is more important to God than our outward behaviour.

Jesus observes people putting money in the treasury of the temple. He also sees the heart of the donors and not only the hands of the donors. He notices a poor widow putting in all that she has relied on. She is a widow (which is bad enough at the time of Jesus) and, she is poor. In a way, she tells the world that what she relies on is God not money. Our Lord acknowledges the generosity of this lady which made her to go down in the history as we see her today. The two copper coins made her the richest person in the world.

God is very generous towards us His children. Are we generous to Him? When it comes to giving to God, we count and are reluctant. Imagine if God counts the costs of giving to us! All that we have and all we own belongs to God. Let us be generous to Him. There is no person in the world who has gone bankrupt just because he/she has been generous to God.
