The Baptism of the Lord and Us.

The Advent season and Christmastide bring to us the great message of the wonderful exchange – the mystery of the Incarnation. The Word which from the beginning is God took flesh and dwelt among us. All who welcomed him received from his fullness, grace upon and grace and have become the beloved sons and daughters of God. At the Epiphany, he is manifested as the “glory of Israel and the light of the nations” and calls upon all the people of the earth to adore him.

Today’s celebration, the Baptism of the Lord, makes clearer to us the privileges of the wonderful exchange. At his baptism, he hallowed the water for baptism, from an ordinary element to a potent-spiritual element capable of achieving spiritual purposes in the lives of Christians. Our spiritual, as well as bodily dirt are washed away, the Spirit has a wholesome place to dwell, and God is made manifest in man. Thus, with our eternal damnation atoned for, we become the beloved sons and daughters of God, coheirs with Christ to the eternal kingdom.

The Sacrament of Baptism bestows an indelible mark on the soul, the person baptised has become a new creation, old things have passed away. Now, being grafted to the person of Christ, every Christian qualifies to be greeted by the words of God the Father, behold my beloved son/daughter in whom I am well pleased. Yes! If we are not God’s beloved, Christ would not have come – he chose us in him (Christ) before the foundation of the world.

@ Baptism the words: I baptise you reassure us the approval of God to make us part of his household in Christ. Consequently, we live not for our wills but the will of God in Christ. Obedience to his will makes us truly his beloved children. We’re called to a humble response to God’s incredible love and not coercive submission; reiterated in the CCC – we’re created in God’s image; to know him, love him, worship and be with him in eternity.

Baptism brings us to share in the life of the Blessed Trinity. The waters of baptism call us to live for the Lord whose body (the Church) we have become. Therefore, it is not just an act conferred on us in a distant past but one which calls us to know and live for him who is embedded in us (@ baptism symbolised by the anointing with oil of chrism) by reverencing the Spirit that unites us; hear his voice and be open to bearing fruits. Furthermore, this new life finds expression in the ongoing renewal within us, in our relationship with one another – we love God in our neighbour. We engage in new creating our society, families, and friends, bring relief to the downtrodden, rejuvenate the lives and faith of lapsed Christians, build bridges that foster love, togetherness, and growth in the light of the Gospel. Baptism makes us members of Christ and more interestingly members of one another – with Christ, we are the Church. We have received of his fullness the Spirit and gifts to enable us build up the body of Christ.

Let us rule ourselves in the light of the Word of God. We are the new word uttered and sent out, embodiment of God’s Spirit – bloom where you are planted. Don’t look for extra you or things to make you up but which can mar the image and the message you carry – show yourself always as the beloved of the Lord. Be generous in words, and actions towards others. Live to the greatest simplicities and avoid the soft and effeminate luxuries which kill the soul, be the message you carry.
