Dear Friends,

People love to have titles as well as degrees next to their names. Of course, those things identify to them who they are and what they have achieved. Jesus has a different standard in comparison with the standards of the world. He doesn't want us to look for titles and honors. Jesus was upset on the scribes and pharisees who looked for titles and places of honor in the synagogues and marketplaces. There was no humility in them. They were particular about what they had to wear and how they must appear in front of people. These same leaders never worried about the common people who were struggling to make ends meet. Apart from the burdens of everyday life they had to carry the religious burdens such as sabbath, fasting etc.

Jesus being compassionate towards people, condemns such behavior of the religious leaders. He challenged them to look beyond their narrow mentality and asked them to help the struggling people. Jesus, by being straightforward in pointing out their mistake, must have irritated these religious as well as leaders of the society. They saw Him as a threat to their long-practiced way of life.

Jesus tells them not to seek titles such as Rabbi, Father, Teacher. First, Jesus wanted them to be worthy of being called so. If someone must be recognized with a particular title, then that person should lead his life in such a way that the person is naturally identified with the title. I wonder what Jesus would say to our present religious leaders who have so many titles and honor but don't live accordingly. I suppose the times have not changed yet since Jesus' time. We, teachers of religion need to be faithful to the teachings of Christ. We don't have to invent the wheel or change the teaching. Jesus has given us what needs to be proclaimed and taught to people. We don't change the teachings of Christ to suit the world but rather we change the world to suit His teachings. The Word of God is eternal whereas we are mere mortals. So let us not try to change the eternal to satisfy the mortals.

Finally, Jesus says in the Gospel: "The greatest among you must be your servant. Anyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and anyone who humbles himself will be exalted."

This is one of the important teachings of Christ. Humility. The virtue that is being forgotten in all aspects of our lives. We must be very aware of pride which can take us away from heaven. Humility does not mean stupidity but rather humbling oneself in front of God almighty. Down through the centuries we have seen God scattering the proud and raising the lowly. Let us acknowledge God as our Supreme and always obey Him. God Bless..

#### ABOUT THE HOLY SOULS IN PURGATORY

#### Who goes to Purgatory?

Those who die in the state of grace, yet without having been purified of all of their attachment to sin, go to Purgatory. Christ admonished us to "be perfect as the heavenly Father is perfect" (Mt. 5:48), and so the purification of all imperfections, which even the good often still have at death, is necessary before entering the Father's Presence.

#### What does repose of the soul mean?

Scripture uses the expression "falling asleep" for death in Christ (1 Cor. 15:20). Thus, repose of the soul means its resting in God until the day of the General Resurrection.

#### Can you pray for the dead?

The Holy Souls cannot pray for themselves, and they are in need of our prayers. We should never assume a person went immediately to God, and even people who went on to be canonized died wanting Masses and prayers to be said for them.

While the Church does not pray liturgically for those who lived and died scandalously, family members and friends certainly may pray for them, hoping that their loved one made a last-minute conversion. If their prayers can't help the person, they are still meritorious for the one who prayed.

It is unnecessary, of course, to pray for canonized Saints, and those who are in Hell are beyond our reach and God's mercy.

#### Can the dead intercede for the living?

Yes, just souls can, whether in Heaven or Purgatory. All the faithful, whether on earth (the Church Militant), in Purgatory (the Church Suffering), or in Heaven (the Church Triumphant), form a "Communion of the Saints" in God, for "He is not God of the dead, but of the living; for all live to Him" (Luke 20:38).

So, while the Holy Souls cannot pray for themselves, we will obtain powerful intercessors and please the Lord with our prayers for them. St. Paul of the Cross once said, "If, during life, we have been kind to the suffering souls in Purgatory, God will see that help be not denied us after death."

#### How do you pray for the departed souls?

Throughout the year, we can have Masses said for the souls in Purgatory, include them in our daily prayers and Rosary intentions, and pray for them when we're near a cemetery. Mother Angelica said, "Every time you pass a cemetery, it's time for a little prayer: 'Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord.' It's just common sense that you help some of them get out of Purgatory."

Venerable Fulton Sheen said, "As we enter Heaven, we will see them, so many of them, coming towards us and thanking us. We will ask who they are, and they will say 'a poor soul you prayed for in Purgatory.'"

#### How long does your soul stay in Purgatory?

The degree of imperfection in each soul which needs purifying is really known only to God. It can also be mitigated by Masses, prayers, indulgences, etc., as described earlier. This means that although relatively speaking different souls will require different degrees of purification that will determine their "time" in purgatory, we cannot know how "long" that will be.

#### Prayer for the Holy Souls in Purgatory by St. Gertrude the Great

St. Gertrude the Great was told by Our Lord that each time she piously recited the following prayer, it would release 1,000 souls from their suffering in purgatory:

Eternal Father, I offer You the most precious blood of thy Divine Son, Jesus, in union with the Masses said throughout the world today, for all the Holy Souls in Purgatory, for sinners everywhere, for sinners in the universal Church, for those in my own home, and in my family. Amen.

St. Gertrude the Great was a 13th-century German nun, writer, and mystic who was graced with many heavenly visions, including being one of the earliest mystics to whom Jesus encouraged a devotion to his Sacred Heart. It is recounted that Jesus showed her a vast number of souls entering heaven from purgatory as a result of her faithful and frequent recitation of this prayer.
