Dear Friends,

The Holy Scripture tells us that there is time for everything. We begin a time of preparation — a season to welcome the Lord. We begin the Advent season this weekend. Advent also initiates the liturgical calendar for the year. Advent prepares us to welcome Christ Jesus. The birth of Christ as a little, fragile and delicate baby is a powerful reminder for us how we need to welcome the Lord in His gentleness and humility. Let us prepare to welcome the Lord in a special way not in a routine manner.

Jesus warns and prepares us through the Gospel passage of this weekend. No one knows about the end of the world. Not even the Son of God in His humanity knows it. Only the heavenly Father knows the day and the time. One may wonder why God chose to keep that day or hour so secret. Does He want us never to know, or does He want to control our lives since we don't know the time or day? Well, the answer is that we don't know. No one knows His intention, but He wants us to be prepared for it.

If we know when we are going to die, our living days will be hell. At times, the thought of death is crueler than the death itself. He wants us to live our lives to the fullest. We need to listen to His warnings and words. We can't take them for granted. Heaven and earth will pass away but His words will never pass away. So let us take His warnings seriously and amend our lives.

As we begin Advent this weekend, let us prepare for Christ in the best way possible. Let this Advent be a time of renewal to all of us. The past is past, and we can look to the future with renewed hope and enthusiasm. Along with our homes, let us also decorate our souls to welcome Christ. We cannot afford to say to Him like that of the Inn keeper, 'there is no place for you in the Inn'. We must open our lives to Christ to welcome Him.

One of the best ways to welcome Christ is to go to confession. Make it as a family renewal time. We may not be regular to confession or not been there for years. It is never late to come back to the Lord with openness to change. Christ will always forgive when we have repentance in our lives. His mercy is more powerful than our sins. Let us have that confidence and prepare ourselves to welcome Christ.

ADVENT

Why do we celebrate Advent?

The Catechism of the Catholic Church (paragraph 524) says, "When the Church celebrates the liturgy of Advent each year, she makes present this ancient expectancy of the Messiah, for by sharing in the long preparation for the Savior's first coming, the faithful renew their ardent desire for his second coming. By celebrating the precursor's birth and martyrdom, the Church unites herself to his desire: "He must increase, but I must decrease."



Why is Advent important to the Catholic Church?

This is a period of preparation for the celebration of the Incarnation at Christmas. As Christmas seems to arrive commercially ever earlier each year, the faithful should try to turn our hearts more toward the Lord.

How do you prepare yourself during Advent?

First, it is a good idea to pray more, possibly including the Joyful Mysteries of the Rosary, the Franciscan Crown, and the Christmas Novena, all of which call to mind the mysteries associated with the Lord coming into the world.

It is also important to read Sacred Scripture, especially the Infancy Narratives of Matthew and Luke. The Catechism of the Catholic Church, chapters 2 and 3 of the Second Part on the Creed, expresses the Church's Faith in the Incarnation and Nativity of the Lord.

Finally, to truly prepare, it is important to go to Confession at least once during the season, and maybe go to daily Mass and do Eucharistic Adoration when you are able.
