LETTER FROM BISHOP VINCENT LONG

12/04/2024

Friday of the Second Week of Easter

To the People of the Parish of Padre Pio Glenmore Park

Dear sisters and brothers,

As we continue to rejoice in the good news of the resurrection of Our Lord it affords the Church the opportunity once again to renew our commitment to be faithful disciples of the Risen One and to recommit ourselves to building up the Body of Christ which finds its local expression in the forty-seven communities that constitute the Diocese of Parramatta.

The Parish of Glenmore Park remains an important and vital part of the community of parishes in the Diocese and whist the departure of a pastor brings with it a time of thanks for what has been gained, it also can be an unsettling time when there is not clarity about the future.

To that end I am pleased to announce that I have engaged with the Provincial of the Somascan Order (The Company of the Servants of the Poor) to take responsibility for the parish of Glenmore Park from 11 May 2024. Initially it is their intention to appoint a priest and then increase the size of the religious community so that they might have a more effective presence in the Parish.

The following paragraph from their website outlines a little of their history and pastoral focus:

The "Company of the Servants of the Poor" was founded in 1534 when Jerome Emiliani called together his collaborators and companions for a general assembly.

This handful of laymen and priests adopted an organised structure for the movement of religious and social reform started by Jerome in 1529, in Venice, Italy.

Their goal was to dedicate themselves to the care assistance, promotion of poor, orphans, and abandoned youth.

From its very beginning, for the good of the Church, and in order to respond to the appeals of her shepherds our Congregation has undertaken various apostolic activities inspired by the love of Christ.

With the same intense love of its Founder, our Congregation continues to devote herself to the material and spiritual care of orphans and the poor, undertakes the human and Christian education of youth and pastoral ministry. (somascanmissions.org.au)

Whilst Padre Pio Parish has its challenges (as every community does in the Diocese) I have every confidence that the Somascan Fathers will build on the strength of what has already been achieved here and take the mission of the Church to another stage of growth and maturity in Faith.

I ask that you pray for the Somascan Fathers as they prepare to come to Glenmore Park and I trust that they will be received with warmth and goodwill when they assume leadership of the ministry here next month.

### **The Eucharist and Vocations**

Author: Fr. John A. Hardon, S.J. THE EUCHARIST AND VOCATIONS Reverend John A. Hardon, S.J.

It is impossible to exaggerate the close relation between the Holy Eucharist and vocations to the priesthood and religious life.

This is only to be expected once we realize that every vocation is a special grace from God, and the greatest source of grace we have is the Eucharist as Presence, Sacrifice, and Communion.

Faith tells us that Christ is really present on our altars, that He really offers Himself in the Mass, and that we really receive Him in Holy Communion. In each case, the Living Christ is now inspiring men and women to give themselves to Him with all their hearts and follow Him in the extension of His Kingdom.

The Eucharist, therefore, is the best way to foster vocations. This means that persons who attend Mass, receive Communion and invoke Christ in the Blessed Sacrament obtain light and strength that no one else has a claim to.

The Eucharist is also the best way to recognize vocations. Show me a man or woman devoted to the Eucharist and I will show you a person who is an apt subject for the priesthood or the religious life.

The Eucharist is finally the infallible way of preserving one's vocation. This is especially true of devotion to the Real Presence. Is it any wonder that saintly priests and religious over the centuries have been uncommonly devoted to the Blessed Sacrament? They know where to obtain the help they need to remain faithful to their vocations. It is from the same Christ Who called them and Who continues to sustain them in His consecrated service.

Vocations begin with the Eucharist; they are developed through the Eucharist; and they are preserved by the Eucharist. All of this is true because the Eucharist is Jesus Christ, still on earth, working through men and women whom He calls to share His Plan for salvation.
