BAPTISMS 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Sundays. Minimum		 Why do they call it Maundy Thursday (also known as Holy Thursday)? "Maundy" comes from the Latin word "mandatum" (command or commandment). At the Last Supper, Jesus gave His disciples this command: "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; even as I have loved you, that you also love one another" (John 13:34). (On this day, Jesus gave us the Sacrament of Holy Orders (the Priesthood) and stayed with us in the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist where He is truly present: Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity). Why do we call it Good Friday? It is called "Good" because through the horrific Passion and Death of Our Lord, He brought about mankind's greatest good—our redemption and the possibility of eternal life with the Holy Trinity.

NOVENA TO THE DIVINE MERCY – begins on Good Friday



Jesus asked for the Sunday following Easter to be dedicated to His Divine Mercy. He also asked that the Feast of the Divine Mercy be preceded by a Novena to the Divine Mercy which would begin on **Good Friday**.

He gave St. Faustina an intention to pray for, on each day of the Novena along with the Chaplet of Divine Mercy.

DAY 1 (Good Friday) All mankind, especially sinners;

DAY 2 (Holy Saturday) The souls of priests and religious;

DAY 3 (Easter Sunday) All devout and faithful souls;

DAY 4 (Easter Monday) Those who do not believe in Jesus and those who do not yet know Him;

DAY 5 (Easter Tuesday) The souls of separated brethren;

DAY 6 (Easter Wednesday) The meek and humble souls and the souls of children;

DAY 7 (Easter Thursday) The souls who especially venerate and glorify Jesus' mercy;

DAY 8 (Easter Friday) The souls who are detained in purgatory;

DAY 9 (Easter Saturday) The souls who have become lukewarm.

THE CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY

1. Begin with the Sign of the Cross, Our Father, 1 Hail Mary and The Apostles Creed.

2. Then on the Our Father Beads say the following: Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins And those of the whole world.

3. On the 10 Hail Mary Beads say the following: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world. (Repeat step 2 and 3 for all five decades)

4. Conclude with (three times): Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
