THE PRECIOUS BLOOD OF JESUS

*July is the month dedicated to
the Precious Blood of Jesus. Let
us turn to Him for daily spiritual
protection: "Most Precious
Blood of Jesus Christ, save us
and the whole world!"*



This devotion has been recognized for centuries, dating back to Christ's death on the Cross. Many saints were devoted to the Precious Blood of Jesus, particularly Saint Catherine of Siena, Saint Mary Magdalen de Pazzi, and Saint Gaspar del Bufalo.

Saint Gaspar del Bufalo, founder of the [Missionaries of the Precious Blood](#), and promoter of the devotion, said, "We must let it be known how the Blood of Christ cleanses the souls and sanctifies them, particularly by means of the sacraments."

Pope Pius IX officially instituted a feast dedicated to the Most Precious Blood of Jesus Christ in 1849. Pope Pius X later assigned July 1 as the designated feast. However, after Vatican II, the Catholic Church traditionally dedicated the entire month of July to the Precious Blood. Many graces can be obtained from this devotion, including spiritual protection, healing, deliverance from evil, growth in virtue, and a deeper understanding of God's mercy and love.

In honor of this month dedicated to the Precious Blood of Jesus, here are eight quick prayers you can recite throughout your day:

1) Prayer Before Praying by Saint Mary Magdalen de Pazzi

"Almighty Father, I place the Precious Blood of Jesus before my lips before I pray, that my prayers may be purified before they ascend to Your divine altar."

2) Prayer of Saint Faustina

"O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a Fount of Mercy for us, I trust in You."

3) Powerful Prayer to the Precious Blood

"Most Precious Blood of Jesus Christ, save us and the whole world!"

4) Saint Catherine of Siena's "Constant Prayer" to the Precious Blood of Jesus

"Precious Blood, ocean of divine mercy: Flow upon us! Precious Blood, most pure offering: Procure us every grace! Precious Blood, hope and refuge of sinners: Atonement for us! Precious Blood, delight of holy souls: Draw us! Amen."

5) House Blessing through the Precious Blood of Jesus

"Precious Blood of Jesus, shed on the Cross for us, bless this house. Take it under Thy protection."

6) Prayer to the Precious Blood of Jesus

"Eternal Father, I offer You the Most Precious Blood of Jesus Christ in atonement for my sins, and in supplication for the holy souls in Purgatory and for the needs of Holy Church."

7) Prayer of Protection through the Precious Blood of Jesus by [Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton](#)

"Lord Jesus, by faith in your merits, I now take your Precious Blood and sprinkle it over myself and my family right from the crown of my head to the very soles of my feet. Amen."

8) Prayer to the Precious Blood When Blessing Yourself with Holy Water

"By this Holy Water and by Your Precious Blood, Lord Jesus, wash away all my sins."

Other longer form prayers include the *Litany of the Most Precious Blood of Jesus*, the *Divine Mercy Chaplet*, etc.

Gospel Luke 10:1-12. 17-20

A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke

Your peace will rest upon him.

The Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them out ahead of him, in pairs, to all the towns and places he himself was to visit. He said to them, 'The harvest is rich but the labourers are few, so ask the Lord of the harvest to send labourers to his harvest. Start off now, but remember, I am sending you out like lambs among wolves. Carry no purse, no haversack, no sandals. Salute no one on the road. Whatever house you go into, let your first words be, "Peace to this house!" And if a man of peace lives there, your peace will go and rest on him; if not, it will come back to you. Stay in the same house, taking what food and drink they have to offer, for the labourer deserves his wages; do not move from house to house. Whenever you go into a town where they make you welcome, eat what is set before you. Cure those in it who are sick, and say, "The kingdom of God is very near to you." But whenever you enter a town and they do not make you welcome, go out into its streets and say, "We wipe off the very dust of your town that clings to our feet, and leave it with you. Yet be sure of this: the kingdom of God is very near." I tell you, that on that day it will not go as hard with Sodom as with that town.'

The seventy-two came back rejoicing. 'Lord,' they said, 'even the devils submit to us when we use your name.' He said to them, 'I watched Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Yes, I have given you power to tread underfoot serpents and scorpions and the whole strength of the enemy; nothing shall ever hurt you. Yet do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you; rejoice rather that your names are written in heaven.'
