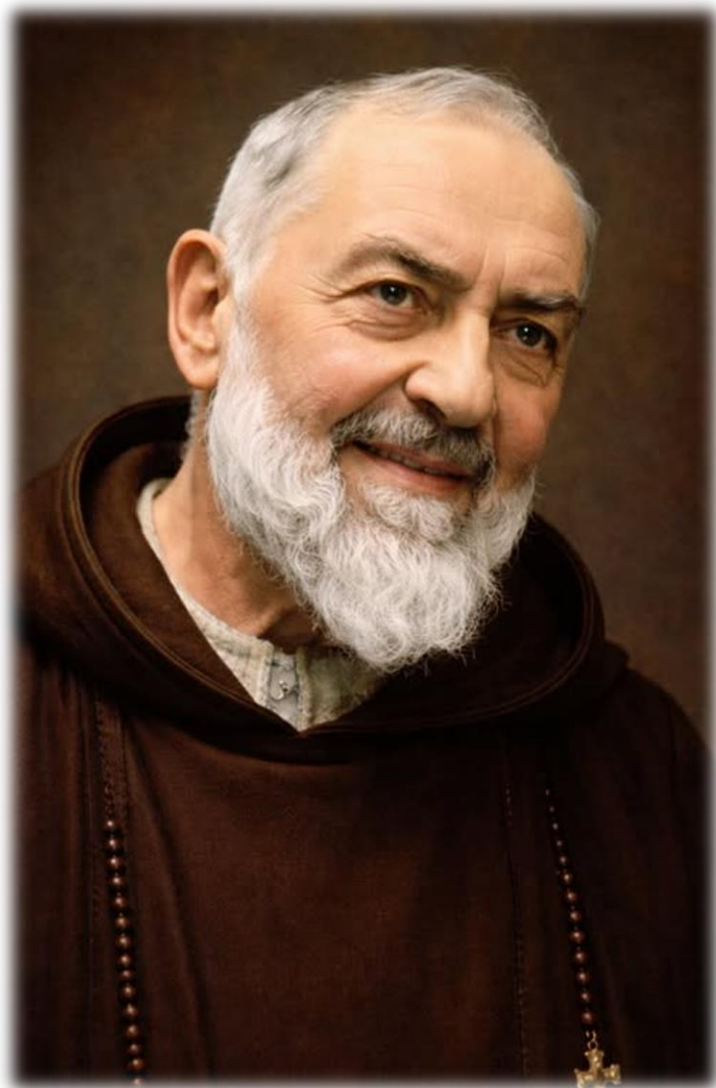

First Reading Jeremiah 1:4-9

A reading from the prophet Jeremiah
